Topic: Homeless Veterans

Summary Frank Konop from the Fire Island Preservation Society. He spoke about how they saved the lighthouse from demolition and funded the building of the Lens Building adjacent which holds the original Fresnel Lens installed in 1857. In addition, the 1826 lighthouse was too short and not too bright, but the current lighthouse was built to use a modern Fresnel Lens. Frank encourages us to visit the lighthouse and climb to the top to see the light in action. It uses 1000-watt bulbs and is 4 times brighter than the average light.
