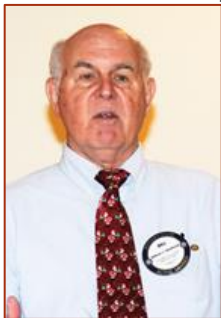

Charitable Donations Report - 2018



President Elect, Bill Skudlarek presented informative data on how the club raises, accounts for, and distributes funds raised by the club's members.

Three major revenue avenues comprise the club's annual fundraising: Pancake Day, the Esther Philhower Auction, and weekly income from meeting sources (prize raffle, Top Dog, and Happy Dollars/Fines.)

Funds are distributed from the Miamisburg Rotary Charitable Trust (mostly auction money targeted for the Trust and major individual donations) and Pancake Fund (proceeds from ticket sales and sponsorships.)

Pancake funds traditionally support local Miamisburg projects – 13 projects in 2018) ranging in amount from \$300 to \$1,500.

Recent MCT projects: The Plaza Theatre, the high school Campus Quest athletic complex, the Riverfront Park water feature, and support for renovation of the girls' basketball locker room at the high school.

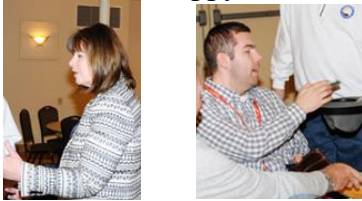
