Tom forced members to take a Foundation test, similar to the SAT or ACT or maybe even the BAR exam. This grueling test focused on the history and philanthropy surrounding the Foundation. Nineteen questions were asked about the Foundation in general and another seven questions focused on the Polio Plus campaign.

Started in 1917, the Foundation has grown its assets to over a billion dollars and supports polio eradication, clean water access, domestic violence programs, raises awareness about bullying, promotes peace, and provides food, clothing, and shelter to families in need around the world.

Along with President Jeff, Tom awarded Paul Harris Fellowship pins to club members who have met the milestone of \$1,000 contribution to the Foundation. Many members in the ceremony received their multiple stone pins (a stone represents each additional \$1,000 beyond the original.) Congratulations.
