HISTORY MAKING SEASON FOR THE VIKINGS AS REGIONAL RUNNER-UPS

The Vikings recorded the most successful season in school history since the modern day playoff system. The Vikings finished the season with a 10 – 3 record as GWOC West Co-Champs and Regional Runner-Ups for the first time in school history. The senior class finished their career at 34-12 with four straight post season playoff appearances and the schools first playoff wins in history. Miamisburg High School has made the post season five times in the schools history (2000-01, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17).

Prior to 1972, the AP voted on the #1 team in the state and there were no playoffs in football. From 1972-1979 the Associated Press voted on a four team playoff for three divisions (AAA, AA, A). In 1980 the playoffs as we know them today were started. At that time there were 6 divisions which took the top 4 teams in each region, 16 teams per division. In 2000-01 the OHSAA expanded the playoff system to the top 8 teams in each region, 32 teams in each division. In 2013 the OHSAA expanded again to seven divisions. Divisions are set every two years based upon each schools boy count of Freshman, Sophomores, and Juniors during the prior Spring. The Vikings are currently on year two of that cycle.
