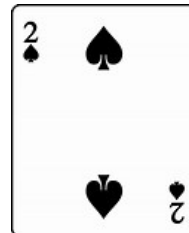

He highlighted the many accomplishments that he and the leadership of the city council were able to achieve.

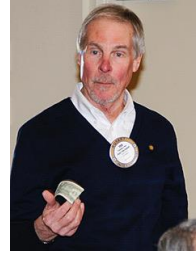
