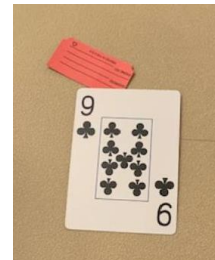
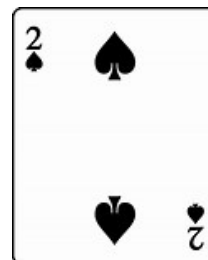

Dick Church introduced U.S. Representative for the 10<sup>th</sup> Congressional District, Mike Turner, who gave an informative program.

Representative Turner focused on five talking points.

1. Dick Church – Rep. Turner said that he first met Dick when Turner was mayor of Dayton. He lauded Dick as not only a city leader but as a regional leader. He said Dick is famous in Washington, DC and around the country as a leader who knows how to persist when most would become discouraged and give up. We are lucky to have Dick save the community from the Mound pull out.
2. Miamisburg Rotary – He said that every member should be recognized for not only dedication to service in Rotary, but for our extensive resumes of serving on multiple groups and multiple issues year after year.
3. WPAFB – The Air Force base is a crucial foundation of the region’s stability. Two major initiatives have survived and thrived in the latest Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) process to improve and increase operational readiness of the department of defense. First 1200 jobs were relocated/created here. The second larger impact was nearly 10 thousand jobs.
4. Department of Defense – the National Space Intelligence Center (NASIC) which will operate at \$182 million budget out of the proposed \$733 billion in 2020.
5. Washington, DC issues that amplify the disfunction of the federal government.
