The levy will essentially replace the two current levies, representing no increase in taxation, however the new initiative will be a continuing levy that does not have an expiration date. John highlighted several cost saving initiatives his team has undertaken in his short tenure resulting in significant savings for the district. He reviewed the budgeting process and data driven approach to forecasting budget needs on a rolling five-year basis.
