

Ron educated those in attendance with details of Centerville's involvement in a Rotary water pump project in Haiti. This project includes application for both District grants and Rotary International Global grant applications.

He showed slides and graphics about his recent trip to Haiti to help drill, assemble, and install a 400-foot-deep water pump system. The chosen system is a LifePump system, distributed through Design Outreach in Columbus.

Without the help of Rotary, several communities in Haiti would be without a source of water other than walking long distances and carrying water from a river in rudimentary containers.
