Enhancing Quality Education in Nepal



A Rotary International Global Grant project sponsored by the Rotary Club of Tripureswor, Kathmandu and the Rotary Club of Bozeman Sunrise, Montana

This three-year project will focus on six rural schools in alignment with Rotary Nepal's Literacy Mission T-E-A-C-H Program (Teacher training, E-learning, Adult Literacy, Child development, and "Happy School").

The Nepal Government created a Sustainable Development Goals & School Sector Development Plan to achieve total literacy and quality education in schools by 2030. The Plan involves instituting teaching methods that develop critical thinking, problem-solving and self-advocacy to foster a more sustainable economy driven by innovation and entrepreneurship.

In support of this Plan, a team of six Bozeman Sunrise Rotarians traveled to Nepal to assist the local club in a Needs Assessment and engaged with locally based academic and NGO partners. Beginning in Spring of 2021, the Global Grant will provide:

- ✓ Teacher training, leadership and mentoring
- ✓ Tools and classroom improvements to support interactive learning
- ✓ E-learning hardware, courseware and training
