Itinerary Overview

Days 1 - 2: Nairobi

Arrive, overnight and then spend your first full day in Nairobi. Pickup day 2 to be advised locally. Guests will visit the Giraffe Center - a refuge for the endangered Rothschild Giraffe that you can hand feed. Next head to the Daphne Sheldrick Trust and Elephant Orphanage where you'll meet the resident elephants and their keepers during their feeding and playtime. The Sheldrick Wildlife Trust is the most successful orphan elephant rescue and rehabilitation program in the world and one of the pioneering conservation organizations for wildlife and habitat protection in East Africa. Afterward, visit the Karen Blixen Museum home of the author of Out of Africa and enjoy lunch at the Talisman Restaurant. *Overnight 2 nights Eka Hotel.*

Days 3 - 9: Lodwar, Turkana

Pickup time advised locally. Depart Nairobi on a private charter and fly to Lodwar in Turkana. Over the next few days guests will visit village projects aimed at mitigating the worst effects of hunger and water scarcity through access to safe water, sanitation, and hygiene services to support family health and economic opportunities.

Four different water boreholes are being rehabilitated and solarized to provide more reliable access to water in this arid region. Women, specifically, are being trained on the maintenance and upkeep of the boreholes. A community gardening project using the reliable borehole water aims to address nutrition issues in these villages. Guests will visit villages impacted by these projects as well as refugee sites in this area. The exact day-to-day details will be finalized in consultation with our local partners closer to the trip - see overview for rough details. *Overnight at The Cradle (local accommodation).*



Day 10: Departure

Bid farewell to Turkana before heading to the airstrip in time for your flight to Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. Pick up time to be advised locally. You'll arrive in time to grab lunch in town before transferring to JKIA and the connection to your onward international departures.



Extension option 1: Maasai Mara National Reserve

Fly to the Maasai Mara (flight times to be advised locally), the crown jewel of Kenya's wildlife reserves. Arriving into Emboo River, you'll be warmly greeted and shown around a camp that has become the beacon of sustainability and environmental stewardship in Kenya. The highlight of the Masai Mara National Reserve is undoubtedly the abundance and variety of wildlife found on the vast plains of the Serengeti and the Masai Mara ecosystem. The Great Migration of zebras and wildebeest begin departing the Mara in September and October, while large prides of lions, elephants, giraffes, gazelles and eland are frequently spotted in the reserve. Head out every morning and afternoon looking for resident wildlife like hyenas and cheetahs. Ask about the possibility of visiting a local village (Talek) or just enjoy the magnificent display of wildlife on an all-day game drive. After a siesta, enjoy an evening game drive in one of the camp's electric vehicles with good chances to see lions, cheetahs, giraffe, zebra and eland. A locally sourced dinner is served family-style in the main area while the sounds of elephants trumpeting echo across the plains. *Overnights at Emboo River.*





Extension option 2: Ol Pejeta Conservancy

Nestled at the base of Mount Kenya, beneath its striking snow-capped summit, Ol Pejeta Conservancy is a haven for wildlife lovers and conservation-minded travelers. This acclaimed sanctuary is home to an extraordinary array of species, including the world's last remaining northern white rhinos.

Guests can experience unforgettable game drives, witness elephants browsing among whistling thorn trees, or quietly observe lions as they stalk the open plains. Beyond traditional safari experiences, Ol Pejeta offers rare access to hands-on conservation efforts, track collared lions with expert researchers, or visit the secure rhino sanctuary to learn about the vital work being done to protect endangered species.

Located in central Kenya, Ol Pejeta is a model for sustainable land use, where cattle ranching and wildlife conservation thrive side by side. For those seeking a deeper connection to nature and its preservation, this conservancy offers a meaningful and inspiring journey. *Overnights at Ol Pejeta Bush Camp. Depending on number of guests interested, may or may not need a night in Nairobi between Turkana and this extension.*

Emboo River Camp, Maasai Mara

Hidden in a forest along a river, Emboo River is positioned in the heart of Kenya's Maasai Mara. It is the perfect spot to explore this spectacular ecosystem and spot all its wildlife. There are animals roaming all around the lodge and sometimes even within Emboo River. Thanks to Emboo's unique sustainable setup, you can enjoy the beauty of the Maasai Mara and also protect it for generations to come.

At Emboo River guests can enjoy silent safaris in solar powered vehicles, dinner under the stars without a generator humming in the background, delicious meals with organic ingredients prepared on bio-gas, rain showers overlooking nature and know that every drop of water is filtered and reused.

The Emboo River team paid special attention to the little luxuries in your suite. The modern furniture was handmade from natural materials by our own team and local artisans. The showers, are made from gumpoles sourced from its own sustainable plantation and your rain shower has running warm water thanks to solar heaters. Emboo River's electricity is provided by the solar panels.

Ol Pejeta Bush Camp, Laikipia

Ol Pejeta Bush Camp offers a traditional safari retreat nestled on the banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River within Laikipia's Ol Pejeta Conservancy. Set beneath the distant outline of Mount Kenya, the camp balances comfort with low-impact design and meaningful conservation engagement.

The camp features seven spacious canvas tents, each with private verandas overlooking the water, en-suite flushing toilets and safari showers, solar lighting, and oversized bedding. Wildlife is abundant: game drives and walking safaris reveal the Big Five, Grevy's zebra, Jackson's hartebeest and up to 300 bird species. Night drives and interactive conservation experiences, like rhino tracking, visiting the chimp sanctuary, canine anti-poaching unit visits, and a Junior Ranger program mean you are spoiled for choice on how to spend each day.

Ol Pejeta Conservancy is home to the world's last two northern white rhinos and provides them with round-the-clock protection. It is also East Africa's largest black rhino sanctuary, playing a vital role in rhino conservation and anti-poaching efforts.

Costs

Base 10-day itinerary: \$5,550 per person based on a minimum of 8 guests in 4 sharing rooms. For a solo room, add \$250.

Maasai Mara - Emboo River 3-night extension: add \$6,195 per person with flights included; for a solo room, add \$575.

OI Pejeta 3 or 4-night* extension: add \$4,295 per person with flights included; For a solo room, add \$1,100. *Depending on number of guests may be able to omit a night in Nairobi and make this 3n.

Other extensions are possible before or after the base itinerary : gorilla trekking in Uganda or Rwanda, beach time in Zanzibar or Pemba - please inquire.
