1. Program Overview: The Lincoln County Logger Days Royalty Scholarship Program promotes youth engagement, community pride, and increased participation in Lincoln County Logger Days through a friendly, sales-based competition open to incoming juniors and seniors from Troy High School and Libby High School.

Students compete individually by selling official entry buttons, with top performers earning royal titles and scholarships. This fosters both inter-school rivalry and personal initiative, recognizing effort and community involvement over academics or activities.

2. Program Goals: Increase awareness and attendance at Lincoln County Logger Days, Encourage positive rivalry between Troy High School and Libby High School, Provide an inclusive, merit-based scholarship opportunity for incoming juniors and seniors, Promote leadership, communication, sales skills, and work ethic, Boost sales of official Lincoln County Logger Days entry buttons

3. Eligible Schools

- Troy High School
- Libby High School

4. Student Eligibility:

- Must be an incoming junior or senior (students entering grades 11 or 12 during the 2026-2027 school year) at Troy High School or Libby High School
- Participation is voluntary
- No GPA, athletic, or activity requirements
- Students must adhere to their respective school's code of conduct throughout the program, including during button sales, event participation, and any royalty appearances
- Open to all qualifying students who register by the deadline and obtain required school sign-off

5. Royalty Structure & Titles

Four royal titles awarded based on individual button sales totals (highest to lowest overall, across both schools):

- King – Top male seller overall
- Queen – Top female seller overall
- Prince – 2nd highest male seller overall
- Princess – 2nd highest female seller overall

Total Recipients: Four (4) (Note: Titles are assigned regardless of school — e.g., if the top two females are both from Libby, Libby claims Queen and Princess; same for males/King/Prince. This drives school pride while rewarding top individual performers.)

6. Awards:

- King and Queen: \$500 scholarship each (paid directly to the student)
- Prince and Princess: \$250 scholarship each (paid directly to the student)
- Total Scholarship Funding: \$1,500
- Each recipient also receives:
 - Official royal title for 2026
 - Public recognition during Lincoln County Logger Days events

7. Method of Selection:

- Royalty recipients determined solely by the total number of official Lincoln County Logger Days entry buttons sold by each student.
- All sales tracked and verified by the committee
- Rankings based on highest verified individual sales totals (separate male/female categories)
- Winners announced during Logger Days events

Tie-Breaker: Any tie resolved by a method determined by the Lincoln County Logger Days Committee (e.g., earliest registration, random draw, or additional sales period).

8. Scholarship Payment Terms

- Funds unrestricted — paid directly to the student
- May be used at the student's discretion, including:
 - College or trade school tuition
 - Tools, certifications, or equipment
 - Transportation or living expenses
 - Future career needs

9. Royalty Recognition- Recipients may be invited to:

- Appear at Logger Days ceremonies, parades, or promotional activities
- Represent Lincoln County Logger Days positively in the community
- Participate in event-related photo ops and announcements

10. Program Oversight & Timeline - The Lincoln County Logger Days Committee oversees:

- Program rules, registration, and timeline
- Button distribution, sales tracking, and verification
- Royalty selection and scholarship distribution

Key Dates (2026):

- Student application/registration deadline: April 1, 2026
- Button sales period: April – June 2026 (exact dates confirmed upon approval)
- Royalty announcement & recognition: During Lincoln County Logger Days, June 19–21, 2026

11. Conclusion: The Lincoln County Logger Days Royalty Scholarship Program celebrates incoming juniors and seniors while fueling excitement for the event. By crowning King/Queen as top sellers and Prince/Princess as runners-up — regardless of school — it rewards hard work, builds friendly competition between Troy and Libby, and strengthens community traditions. With \$1,500 in total scholarships and a focus on school code of conduct compliance, this initiative supports youth and ensures Logger Days remains a vibrant celebration of Lincoln County spirit.
