



When the Livingston Rotary Club got word that the wading pools were closing down, Rotarians approached the City of Livingston to see if we could build a Water Spray Park in our town similar to spray parks in Butte and Helena. The City agreed that it was a good idea, started researching locations and ultimately decided on Mike Webb Park. In 2008, Rotary started to actively solicit grants and donations. In 2011, enough funds were raised to complete Phase I of the project.

Phase I, scheduled to be completed fall 2012, includes building the restrooms, changing rooms and equipment shed, laying pipes under the splash pad, connecting to City of Livingston water and sewer lines, and pouring the concrete splash pad.

Phase II involves purchasing the fun, interactive water features that attach to the splash pad like the Super Splash bucket, Ground Geyser, and Water Tunnel, installing the recirculation system, UV filtration system and water tank. The recirculation and UV systems will clean the water and allow it to be reused the entire summer season. *When operable, the Water Spray Park will purify and recycle over 7,400 gallons of water per hour!*

Our goal is to have Phase II completed by spring so we can all enjoy the park by Memorial Day 2013. We appreciate your continued financial support!
