Introduction

The Rotary Club of Granville recognizes that on certain days it may be difficult or impossible for members, speakers and guests to attend meetings due to excessive snow, ice or other inclement weather. This policy addresses situations, which are deemed as weather emergencies. In recognition of these special circumstances, the Board of Directors of the Rotary Club of Granville hereby establishes the following Inclement Weather Policy:

Inclement Weather Policy

Definitions:

1. Level 1 Snow Emergency: Indicates that roads are hazardous with blowing and drifting snow or ice covered.
2. Level 2 Snow Emergency: Indicates that roads are hazardous with blowing and drifting snow or ice covered. Only those who feel it is necessary to drive should be out on the roads.
3. Level 3 Snow Emergency: All roads are closed to non-emergency personnel. No one should be out during these conditions unless it is absolutely necessary to travel. Those traveling on the roads may subject themselves to arrest.

Should a Level 3 weather Emergency be declared by the Licking county Sheriff, on a regular meeting day, the Rotary Club of Granville's meeting shall be cancelled. The club's President or his or her designee shall notify the membership and the Granville Inn of the meetings cancellation via email, before 10:00 a.m. It shall be the responsibility of individual members to notify their guest. The monthly program chair shall notify guest speakers of the cancellation with as much advanced notice as practical.

Should a Level 2 weather Emergency be declared by the Licking county Sheriff, on a regular meeting day, the President of the Rotary Club of Granville may, at his or her discretion, cancel a scheduled meeting. The club's President or his or her designee shall notify the membership and the Granville Inn of the meetings cancellation via email, before 10:00 a.m. It shall be the responsibility of individual members to notify their guest. The monthly program chair shall notify guest speakers of the cancellation with as much advanced notice as practical.
