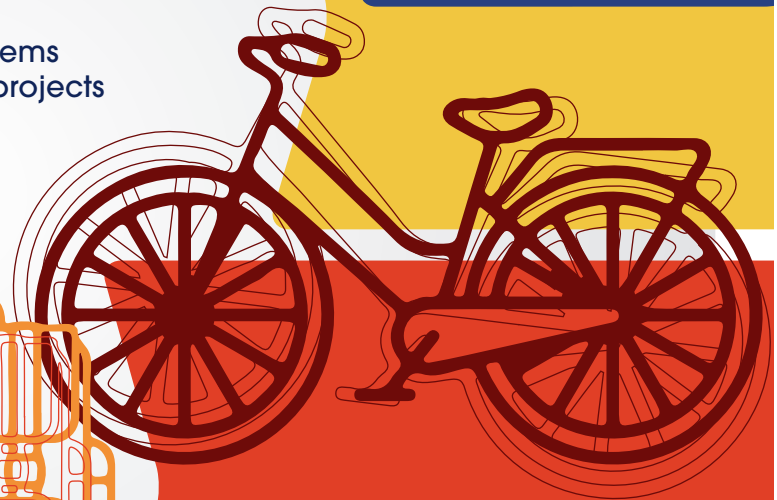
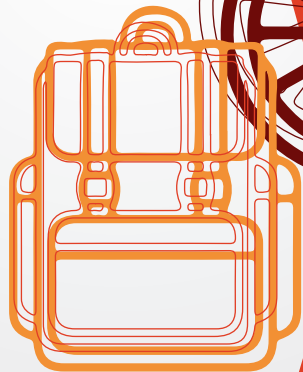

Celebrating its 20th year, **Backpacks for Kids**

started in 2004 when the Sunrise Rotary Club partnered with Traverse City Area Public Schools (TCAPS) to ensure every elementary student had a backpack full of needed supplies. Each year TCAPS provides a list of elementary students, and Club members fill and distribute 1,400 backpacks. We also provide backpacks to the Student Support Network, Northwest Education Services, Child and Family Services, Big Brothers Big Sisters, and other community partners and any family that needs back-to-school support. After this year, the total number of backpacks distributed since the program began will exceed 23,000!

Born to Read spreads the word about the importance of reading with children every day from birth on, providing a book to every newborn delivered at Munson Medical Center. New parents can also enroll their babies in Dolly Parton's Imagination Library and receive age-appropriate books at no cost every month until their 5th birthday. We also distribute books to young children and literacy tips to families through community partners such as Father Fred Pantry to Preschool project, Traverse Area District Library, TCAPS, Grand Traverse Health Department, and more. Last year Born to Read distributed 5950 books to children in our community.

Education for Malawi:

Since 2016, club members have traveled to the Mangochi district of Malawi to help address educational needs. In 2021, we began providing bicycles for student and teacher transportation to four secondary schools, vocational bicycle repair training, and established a bicycle repair operation. The program has been very effective and we plan to further support students at the four schools and launch two more schools in 2024/25 providing 290 additional bicycles. Twelve Rotary members from four different clubs plan to visit Malawi again in October 2024 to celebrate with our schools and launch the next phase of the bicycle program.
