- * Christine Robere and Jodi Nichols presented on the United Way ALICE (Asset Limited and Income Constrained, Employed) initiative using some interactive exercises illustrating economic vulnerabilities of lower wage workers when confronted with emergency expenses e.g. medical, car and home repairs, etc. Nichols Paper has offered a \$25K challenge grant during the month of March to raise dollars specifically to support the ALICE initiative.
