- 50/50 raffle. Do away with prizes, just have one winner of the 50/50.
- It was agreed that we would do this again next year and the funds that would be raised would go towards the trips for next winter.

Other notes:

The ReWine group would like to be involved (partner with) more community events such as the community mixer in Muskegon Heights on May 25.

It was also decided that 10% of any funds raised by the ReWine group would be put into a fund to help out with miscellaneous items that the ReWine group determines it would like to donate to (i.e. help with students wanting to attend conferences, etc.)
