Annual Meeting & The Gift of Life: Saving Lives Through Organ Donation

The Gift of Life Michigan is a federally designated organ and tissue donor program that works close with 130 hospitals and eight transplant programs in our State.


Organ donors can save up to eight lives and tissue donors can help heal an average of 75 (up to 125) individuals. The transplant waiting list has more than 103,000 patients on it and every nine minutes a new name is added to the list. One average, 17 patients die per day while waiting for an organ transplant. Linda Johnson shared her experience of receiving a transplant from someone who was at the age of 34.
