

Rotary Park Monthly Update April 2015

Fellow Rotarians,
We've had a very active April. Key staff met with Hooker/De Jong to finalize Phase 1 of Rotary Park; everything looks great. This rendering, right, was then sent off to Revel to design the "coming soon" signs, very similar to those seen at the Muskegon



Farmer's Market two years ago. After meeting to discuss the phased approach, a contract was drawn up for design and project coordination with Hooker De Jong, who will work with County Purchasing for bid solicitation. We are being asked by the DNR to rebid the phased project because the change in scope of project construction has changed dramatically.



Phase 1 will be completed, as scheduled. Bid notification should be published yet this week. We anticipate construction by June 2015. The signs were installed at the end of April; we thank Bob Lukens for coordinating that effort. It really



helps bring the project to its next steps. Bob provided us pictures of the installed signage. Rotarians, please stop by and see the progress we've made. Muskegon County wants to thank all of you for your patience as new staff members work to complete the project. We anticipate the YMCA parking lot resurfacing and easement execution in May 2015. This will ensure that parking is available as we assess the needs of parking in the future for the park.
