Meeting tonight spent working on Get Your Chili On event. Updates as follows:

- Serving cups were numbered. We have 40 cups each for 24 pots of chili.

- 24 confirmed pots of chili, we have several people on the wait list but want to see how ticket sales go.

- We will need 4 additional volunteers from each high school. Students will get names so we can make them special nametags.
