Program – Bowelscan Max Fry and Kimberley Rice



Kimberley is a theatre nurse at St John of God Hospital. Kimberley's passion for raising awareness about bowel cancer came as a result of the loss of her father to the disease only two weeks after being diagnosed.

Bowel cancer begins as polyps which can develop into cancer. The positive aspect of this particular cancer is that with early diagnosis over 90% of cases are cured. Regular testing is therefore highly recommended and one of the best ways to do this is through one of Rotary's own programs – Bowelscan.

Max has had a long involvement with Bowelscan both at a local level in Geelong and also right across the whole district. The most pleasing aspect of Max's work are the letters from people who have taken the test and received a positive result which enabled them to take life saving action.

Bowel cancer can strike at any age and Australia has the second highest incidence of the disease in the world. What more incentive is there then to buy a bowelscan kit next May or even better book an appointment with a doctor – just to make sure!!
