TRELLO FOR DUMMIES:

TO GET STARTED:

1. Go to trello.com
2. Sign Up
3. Name = your name
4. Email = your email address - prefer your Rotary email that your invitation came on - so you will be linked to Rotary Team immediately.
5. Password = choose your own password.
click Create New Account.

THEREAFTER:

1. Login: Email (or username) and Password that you chose.
2. Go to 'Rotary Club Monday' boards. ("board" means a noticeboard)
3. Go to next meeting date.
4. For Apology: left click, hold the mouse down, and drag your name from 'Attending Meeting' to APOLOGY list and release your name in the shadow.
5. For Guest: Click 'Add Card' at the bottom of the 'Attending Meeting' List, and type your guest's name.

Or: choose your guests name from the 'Partner, Permanent Apology, Honorary' List - click and drag name to 'Attending Meeting' List.

ALSO:

USE Trial BOARD to practice.

On iPad and smart phone: download the app 'TRELLO'. for free.

The app does most things you need.

ADMINS who add boards and new dates will need to use the full Trello version on a computer (not the app) at trello.com.
