District Governor Ian McKay assisted Vocational Director James Dunn and Gerri Griffin to present these awards See attached pdf for their citations.

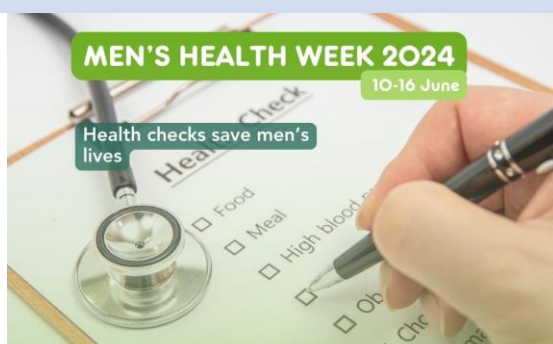
DG Ian spoke about the importance of Vocation and the values of Rotary.

District 9780 Donations in Kind has changed its name. We are now operating as RARE (Rotary Australia Repurposing Equipment).



District 9780 RARE Activities

- A 40 ft container with hospital beds, medical equipment and 50 computers was sent to Sri Lanka.
 - Nine pallets of medical equipment and general goods were sent to Ukraine.
 - A 20 ft container with educational, medical, and general goods was sent to Vanuatu.
 - We are currently loading a 20 ft container to go to Rabaul in PNG at the end of May. As well as educational, medical, and general goods, it contains a building kit to be erected as a community centre for a local village.
 - A container to go to Popondetta in PNG is scheduled to be sent in September.
- Our computer group are assembling 10 Teacher in a Box laptops/servers to go to Somalia in late June.
