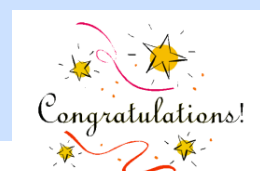

We hope that every member has a Rotary shirt that should be worn when out at these projects.

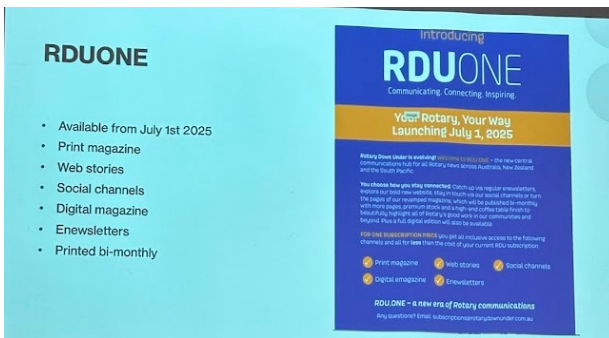
