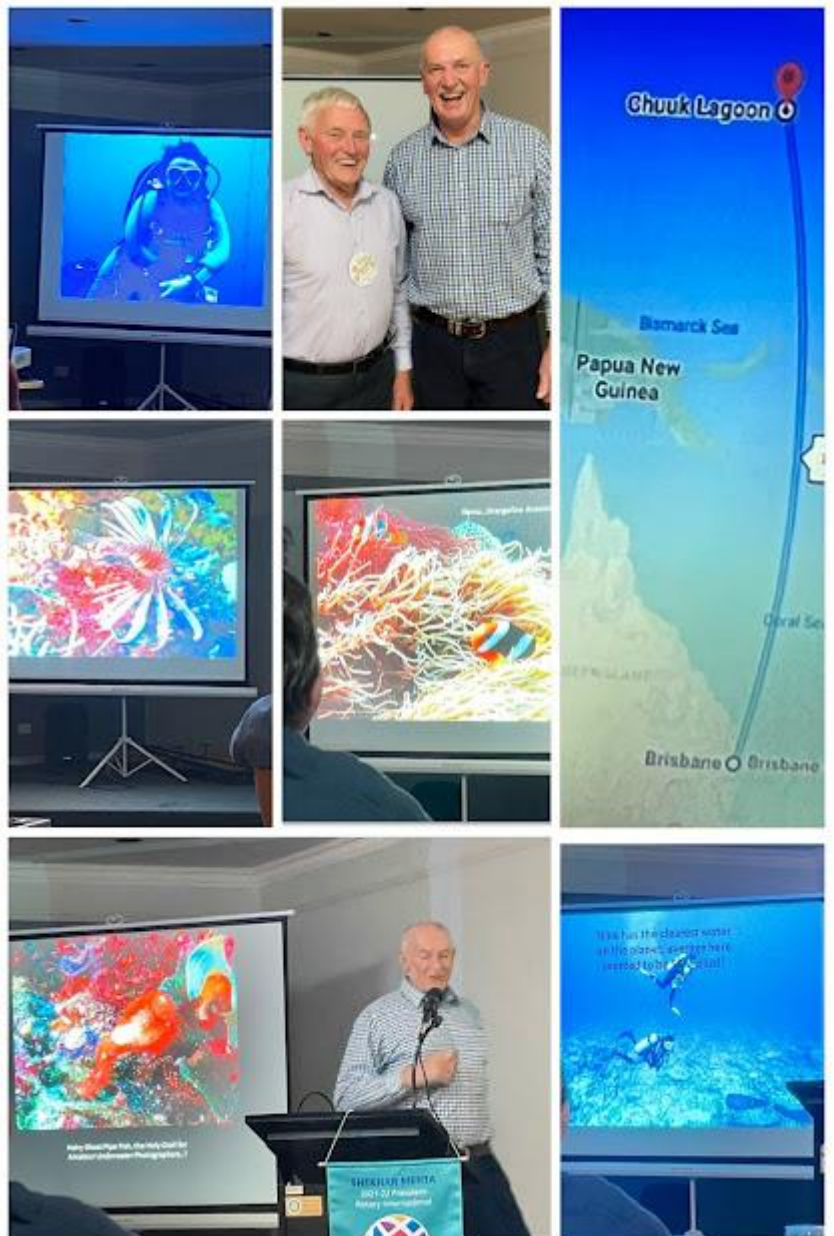
## Guest Speaker

Rotarian Kevin Safe introduced guest speaker Russell Robinson to speak Dive Travel Misguided Adventures.

Russell spoke of the diving tours he conducted to Truk Lagoon in the central Pacific Ocean, about 1800 Km. north of Papua New Guinea, Milne Bay at the southeastern tip of Papua New Guinea and at Niue Rock, a rock island in the south Pacific Ocean.

Both Truk and Milne Bay were significant military sites in World War 2 and both provide a fascinating source of interest for divers as a result of the large numbers of sunken warships and aircraft. Both Truk and Milne Bay, and Niue Rock, provide a wide array of sea creatures due to their temperate conditions and warm seas. Russell illustrated his talk with a number of excellent photographs.

After Russell had answered a number of questions, President Brian thanked Russell and closed the meeting.
