### Aboriginal Art – Lorraine Wilson

**After a recent trip to the NT Lorraine shared some insights into the indigenous art available and showed a piece that she had purchased.**

While Aboriginal art has been around for tens of thousands of years, the Aboriginal Art Movement, and in particular painting, has more recent origins

1934 Albert Namatjira inspired to paint in watercolors by some visiting artists

1971 School children encouraged to paint about their life – using acrylics and dots at Papunya Settlement near Alice Springs

1981 Aboriginal art was included in major exhibitions in Sydney

1980 Aboriginal Cooperatives set up

1988 Aboriginal art used in new Parliament House and for Olympic Games so more recognition.

May 2007 saw the first piece of indigenous art sold for more than \$1 million, the [Emily Kame Kngwarreye](#) piece, Earth's Creation
