## Rotary bowel scan reminder

ROTARY Hamilton has for many years supported the sale of Rotary Bowelscan Kits from our local pharmacy.

These will no longer be available, but members of the public were encouraged to continue to monitor their bowel health through the National Bowel Cancer Screening Program

June is Bowel Cancer awareness month, so it is timely to issue a reminder that bowel cancer claims the lives of 103 Australians every week (5350 people a year) - but it's one of the most treatable types of cancer when detected early.

This program aims to reduce deaths from bowel cancer by detecting early signs of the disease.

If found early, more than 90 per cent of cases can be successfully treated.

From July 1, the eligible screening age is being lowered from 50 to 45. This means people aged 45 to 49 can join the program.

- People aged 45 to 49 can request their first bowel cancer screening kit be mailed to them.

- People aged 50 to 74 will continue to receive a bowel cancer screening kit in the mail every two years.

- If you're 75 or over, you can ask for a kit every two years by phoning the free bowel cancer screening helpline.

- If you're worried about a family history of bowel cancer or have any symptoms, speak to a GP for advice.
