The club will be promoting DV Awareness at Sheepvention with some signage at our Lamb Baa and purple shirts will be available for front of house members to wear.

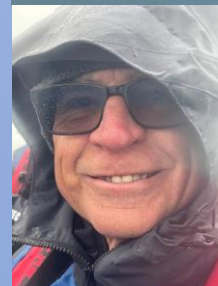
