TYPES OF MISTREATMENT AND ABUSE

Identified for **Psychological Abuse**: Treating, humiliating, harassing, or forcing which causes a loss of self-esteem or a sense of helplessness.


Financial Abuse: Using someone's money, property or other assets illegally or without their consent to change their will or legal documents.

Physical Abuse: Hitting, pushing, pinching, or using force.

Sexual Abuse: Forcing someone from engaging with family, friends or services. This can be made permanent unless they find out about other forms of abuse.

Abuse: Abuse is any action that causes the older person to feel distressed.

PREVALENCE OF ELDER ABUSE

1 in 6 older Australians are experiencing some form of abuse:

- psychological abuse (11.7%)
- neglect (2.9%)
- financial abuse (2.1%)
- physical abuse (1.8%)
- sexual abuse (1%)
