Just a reminder to make sure you apologize online for all meetings. The club incurs expenses for non-attendance, and you will be asked to pay.

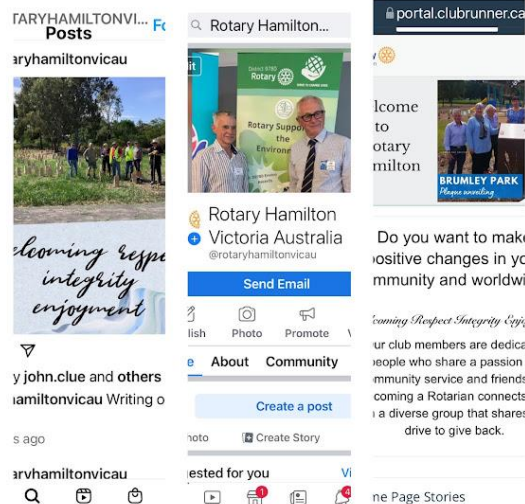
Social media

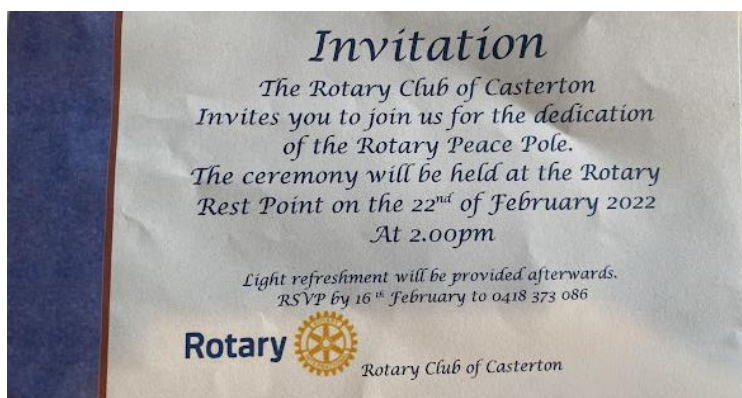


February Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution Month

A Peace Pole is an internationally

recognized symbol of the hopes and dreams of the entire human family, standing vigil in silent prayer for peace on earth. Each Peace Pole bears the message **May Peace Prevail on Earth** in different languages on each of its four or six sides. There are estimated over 250,000 Peace Poles in every country in the world dedicated as monuments to peace.
