Haiti has the highest maternal and infant mortality rate of any country in the western hemisphere.

Rotary provided a fully equipped medical Jeep to volunteers and midwives to reach mothers and children in remote areas.

What WDHS is doing for mothers and babies

Western District Health Service (WDHS) is introducing a new model of maternity care, with the wellbeing of mothers and babies, as well as the long-term sustainability of the service at its heart.

The new service combines the expertise of local GP Obstetricians with care from experienced WDHS midwives, all in one location.

The WDHS Maternity Service offers an approach to childbirth that is based on family-centred care, promoting pregnancy and childbirth as a normal healthy life event.

Each woman is allocated to a midwife, with support from one or more midwives from within the team, in collaboration with the GP Obstetrician / Obstetrician.

- Antenatal and postnatal mental health support
- Midwifery outpatient support
- Postnatal home visiting midwifery service
- Alliances with other health professionals as required such as dietitians, physiotherapists and social workers

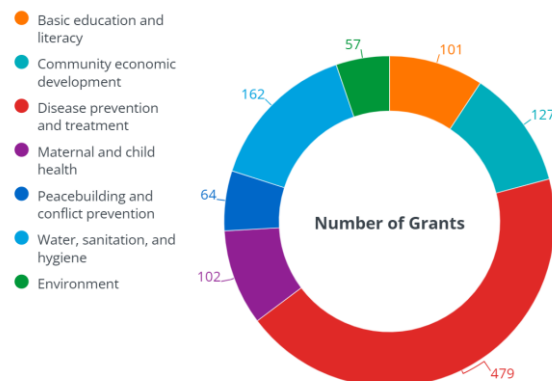
