OUR CLUB (1136)

The Rotary Club of Jackson Hole (Lunch Club) was chartered in 1941 in the historic Wort Hotel (which was opened the same year). We meet every Tuesday from 12-1pm. Meetings include lunch, social time to connect with other members and a special guest presentation.

JH ROTARY FOUNDATION

The JH Rotary Foundation is our local club's nonprofit foundation. Our local Foundation distributes an average of \$200,000 a year in scholarships to students in our community. It is led by a separate, independent board.

Prospective Member Information

THE MEMBERSHIP PROCESS

A prospective member attends three meetings (in a suggested 60 day window) with a designated sponsor (current Rotarian). Upon completion of their third meeting a prospective member may submit their application, a brief bio and \$65 application fee to our club's Membership Chair. The Membership Chair will set up a brief meeting to review club expectations, member obligations and answer any questions from the prospective member.

Once the application and bio are received, the Membership Chair will submit materials to the Board of Directors. Upon board approval, applications are sent to the full club for a seven day review period.

Upon membership acceptance, the Board Secretary and Membership Chair will welcome the new member and provide any necessary materials and resources for their membership.

MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS

Our club offers a variety of membership options. If you are unsure what membership best suits you, please contact our Membership Chair.

- **Individual Membership**
 - Dues of \$275 per quarter (\$1,100 per year)
- **Corporate Membership**
 - Dues of \$375 per quarter (\$1,500 per year)
 - One official Rotarian, up to three people on "lunch list" who can attend meetings in their place
- **Introductory Membership**
 - Reduced dues of \$175 per quarter for first two quarters (six months, opt-in)
- **Under 40 Membership**
 - Dues of \$175 per quarter (\$700 per year, opt-in)

SPONSOR A ROTARIAN

Any individual member may elect to "Sponsor a Rotarian" for an additional \$100 per quarter (or any amount you would like). These sponsors make it possible for us to provide a variety of membership options to meet the needs of our community.

DUES STRUCTURE

- Dues are billed quarterly.
- In addition to your Rotary Lunch Club dues, you may elect to add a suggested \$25 per quarter to the JH Rotary Foundation and/or to the Rotary International Foundation.
