

2019 ENHANCED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Rotary Club of Marblehead Harbor will award a number of scholarships for 2019. RCoMH will choose one (1) candidate for The Fraffie Welch Scholarship-- a four (4) year scholarship of \$2500 per year (\$10,000 over 4 years). Recipients of other RCoMH scholarships will each be awarded lesser amounts up to a combined total of \$6,000. These scholarships will be in the form of single year grants that are not renewable.

- b. Include a copy of your most recent academic transcript.
- c. Submit seven copies (1 original, 6 copies).
- d. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS OR APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
- **2. SUBMISSION DEADLINE**: The application <u>must be received</u> by Monday, April 1, 2019, before 4p.m.

4. ELIGIBILITY:

- a. any graduating senior of Marblehead High School; or
- b. a graduating senior, who is a resident of Marblehead, but attends an out-of-town high school;
- c. a graduate who intends to pursue a degree from an accredited college, university or vocational school beginning the following semester
- d. Children and grand-children of Rotarians are not eligible to apply.

5. The ideal candidate is an individual:

- a. who has a strong academic record;
- b. has demonstrated leadership, determination and integrity; and
- c. who can best represent the values of Rotary--building goodwill and friendship, high ethical standards, concern about the needs of society, and the ideal of Service above Self.
- **6.** The Rotary Club of Marblehead Harbor scholarship program does not discriminate by race, color, creed, gender, sexual preference, disability or national origin.
- **7.** Financial need will be considered.
- **8.** Finalists may be asked to meet with the scholarship committee to review this information. The applicant will be contacted to set up an interview date.
