<u>Lawrence Rotary, Inc.</u>, club # 701, organized on March 26, 1920, is one of 48 clubs in District 7930. Our club consists of over 80 men and women representing the business community. The Lawrence Club is one of 32,205 Rotary Clubs in 168 countries, with over 1.21 million members worldwide. Our club strives to build a better community, emphasizing activities by club members that enhance the quality of life and human dignity, encouraging high ethical standards and creating greater understanding among its people.

Attendance Requirements

Our club meets weekly each Thursday at the Gr. Lawrence Technical School, 12:15 – 1:30 PM. (Be there 5-10 minutes early to check in at the Secretary's desk.) While we would like you to be present at each meeting we understand there are times when you cannot be with us. In those cases we encourage you to attend a Rotary meeting in another location; if you travel, there are over 32,000 clubs in 168 countries. When you make-up at another club, their club secretary will give you a card that notes the date and place of your make-up. When you turn that card in to our club secretary, you will receive a meal credit on your next quarterly bill and your attendance gets credited. You may also get attendance credit (not meal credit) for participating in club-sponsored activities, e.g., Read-aloud, softball, science club, and attendance at Board and committee meetings. The Rotary By-laws require a minimum of 60% attendance to maintain active membership.
