**Air Canada Centre bag policy** — General sessions will be held at the Air Canada Centre, which strictly enforces its personal bag policy. The arena prohibits purses or briefcases larger than 14 by 14 by 6 inches (or about 35 by 35 by 15 centimeters). No backpacks will be allowed into the building. Permitted bags should be soft-sided and fit completely under the arena seats. The Air Canada Centre is unable to store oversized or prohibited items. It will make an exception to the policy for declared medically necessary items, after proper inspection.
