In the News

This week, we heard from Equity, a grass roots organization created by two highschoolers. They saw the need for updating period products at schools. They are now in seven Kansas Public high schools, and they send period kits to the nurses at each school. Approximately 16.9 million menstruating women live in poverty in the United States. Among those women, two-thirds said they struggled with affording menstrual products in the last year, and 14% of college girls in a study surveyed said they struggled to afford period products. Rotarians *generously & spontaneously* donated to Equity at the Nov 17th meeting.

During the REACH session, Lorna and Ron presented scenarios related to navigating through issues that could impede college completion. The mentors acted out each of the scenarios and students worked in small groups to discuss solutions to each scenario.

Ron added commentary on the issue of agility and understanding that you can adjust who you are and how you engage by developing along the way.
