Preparation

Please **wear closed toe shoes** during your shift and comfortable clothes.

Description of Shift

We will unlock the doors before your scheduled shift. We have a large parking lot. You may enter through the glass doors. If they are locked, please ring the doorbell.

Check-in and learn how HappyBottoms is working to eliminate diaper need in the KC region, tour the warehouse and receive training.

Volunteers wrap diaper packages, fill monthly orders for agencies and hospitals and complete other tasks as requested. Wrapping diapers includes taking diapers out of boxes/bags, counting, bundling together, wrapping with a machine or by hand and attaching labels. Filling orders includes counting and placing diaper packs onto carts/pallets and placing them in bags/boxes according to order requirements.

There will be light cleaning, sanitizing, recycling and disposing of trash created during the shift. Time will be allocated at the end of the shift to take photos, provide us feedback about your experience and celebrate what you accomplished!

Safety

Once volunteers arrive all doors are locked from the outside.
