### set for Oct 19

Ottawa - Canadian Prime Minister Stephen Harper dissolved parliament Sunday and called for general elections on October 19.

The announcement marks the official kickoff of an 11 week-long campaign in which PM Stephen Harper the Conservative leader will seek a fourth straight term in power, with the sluggish economy expected to be a central issue.

## Polls give PP slight lead

Port-of-Spain - The general elections in Trinidad and Tobago is just over a month away, and the polls are showing a return to power of the incumbent People's Partnership government. However, at this time, the lead held by the PP government over the opposition People's National Movement is a slim one, with the polls showing the outcome of the elections would be decided by the marginal seats, and perhaps may even come down to one constituency becoming the prize acquisition.

Such was the finding by the pollsters, one of them being the North American Caribbean Teachers Association. Its ongoing tracking opinion poll has indicated the PP leading the PNM in seven of the nine marginal constituencies.

Harper, in power since 2006, announced the election after meeting with Governor General David Johnston, the representative of Queen Elizabeth II, Canada's nominal head of state in this Commonwealth country.

Harper said the election was about "leadership on the big issues that affect us all, our economy and our nation's security."

At the time when NACTA conducted its poll, neither the PP nor the PNM was showing it was attracting over 50 percent support in any of the marginal constituencies. The contests in several constituencies remain close, suggesting these can go either way on September 7.
