- **Diane Bourke** recently joined Rotary, and **Jayne Rayno** received a pin for introducing Diane to the Club.

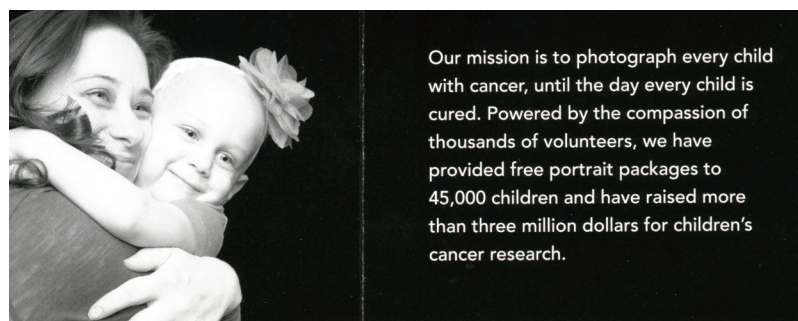
## PROGRAM

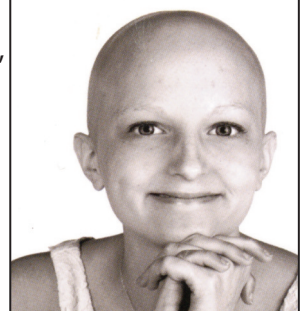
