Proposing a New Member

The Key Considerations Are:

- Identify an individual with discretionary time.
- Someone with an interest in community service, Rotary, our projects/activities.
- Proposed new member should reside in territorial area of our Club which includes *West Andover, Bradford, South Danbury, Newbury, New London, Springfield, Sunapee, Sutton, Warner and Wilmot* OR he/she must be employed by a company/business within the territorial area.
- Goal is to broaden our membership to reflect the business and residential life of the community.
- Need members who will participate and be involved.
- Retirees who would have met the criteria during their career are eligible.

The Key Steps Are:

1. **Invite prospect/potential new member** to a breakfast meeting as your guest. Determine possible interest in Rotary (*i.e. ask about impressions*).
2. **Inform Membership Committee Chair(s)** of possible proposal. The name of the proposed member will then be posted on ClubRunner. Members will be notified via email to login to ClubRunner. If any member has an objection, this will happen through ClubRunner within 7 days from the posting.
3. Simultaneously, the President will request a contingent vote from the Board. ***If there is no objection within 7 days from a club member***, in writing, the new member is approved
4. **Once approved, membership may be discussed with candidate.**
5. **Candidate meets with Membership Committee Chair(s)** for orientation and the **Membership Application Form** is completed.
6. **Induction is arranged and carried out.**
