Scholarship Qualifications and Guidelines

- 1. The applicant shall be enrolled as a High School Senior of University High School, Deltona High School, Pine Ridge High School, or Trinity Christian Academy and on track to graduate. Applicant must live in the club's service area.
- 2. Grades, Extra Curricular Activities and Community Service are each given equal weight and must be documented and included with this application. The Rotary Scholarship criteria requires the applicant to have engaged in significant community service (more than 75 hours) and school activities in addition to maintaining a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- 3. Applicant must be seeking a Bachelor's degree, AS degree or Vocational degree from an accredited institution in the United States of America.
- 4. Rotary of DeBary, Deltona and Orange City scholarships are open to applicants majoring in all fields.
- 5. An acceptance letter/confirmation of registration must be submitted by May 1, 2023 and student id number provided in order to receive scholarship at/prior to graduation.
- 6. An essay of 500-750 words must be submitted with application using the guidelines outlined in this application.

WHAT IS THE FOUR-WAY TEST?

The Four-Way Test is a nonpartisan and nonsectarian ethical guide for Rotarians to use for their personal and professional relationships. The test has been translated into more than 100 languages, and Rotarians recite it at club meetings:

Of the things we think, say or do

- 1. Is it the TRUTH?
- 2. Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4. Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Based on this information please submit an essay of 500-750 words answering the following:

How the Four-Way Test has applied to your involvement in Interact or your community service work?

What are your future plans?

How would you apply the Four-Way Test as you graduate and move forward with your academic or vocational endeavors?
