Membership Fees

Quarterly dues for individuals are \$125. New members also pay a one time \$50 initiation fee. Individuals must submit a check for \$175 with this application to cover the initial fee and first quarter dues.

Corporate membership dues are \$325 per quarter which includes all lunch and dinners for one corporate member per meeting. Corporate membership allows substitute attendees from the same organization. A check for \$375 is due for the first quarter to cover the initiation fee.

Meals are \$20 per meeting and include a buffet lunch or dinner. Club dues are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes, but they may qualify as a business expense. Please consult your tax adviser.
