Happy September and Happy Fall...*where did summer go?!*

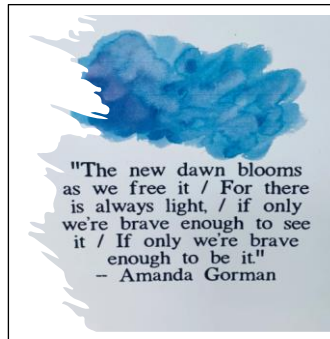
