



ORGANIZATION MEMBERSHIP BREWSTER ROTARY

Purpose

The Organization Membership will allow a corporation, company or organization in Brewster Rotary's "territory" to become a member of the Brewster Rotary club. The goal of this membership category is to increase the club's ability to attract and retain a qualified and diverse professional base within the community by allowing flexibility that is potentially desired by prospective members.

Organization Members will still go through an approval process and can appoint up to three designees as the individuals who will attend club meetings, assist with projects and fundraisers, vote on club matters, and serve as club officers and on club committees.

Guidelines

1. **Approval.** A corporate entity, business or organization can apply for membership in Brewster Rotary. The process will be as follows: (1) Each designee attend 1-2 regular club meetings as a potential member, (2) Fill out Corporate Membership Application and submit to membership committee for review and ultimate board approval, (3) Each designee must receive a New Member Orientation, and (4) Corporate entity, business or organization is inducted into club. (Preferably all three designees should be present for induction.)
2. **Designees.** The corporate entity, business or organization will name up to three persons to be designees.
3. **Changing designees.** Designees can be changed upon approval of the club's board of directors.
4. **RI and District registration.** Per RI's and District 7210's current policies, only one designee (referred to as 'Senior Designee') can be listed as an official member of the Rotary club. Each designee will be listed in Brewster Rotary's club directory under the corporate entity, business or organization.
 - a. Additional Senior Designee – for the Rotary Year 2025-2026 the organization may wish to have more than one and up to three Senior Designees. Each additional Senior Designee will have dues costs of \$75.00 per quarter this includes RI dues, district dues, Rotary magazine and club dues. It does not include meals.
 - b. The corporation may have two or three senior designees with meals at twice or three times the dues rate (\$300.00 per quarter as of 2025-2026)
5. **Dues.** The financial obligations of an eligible corporate entity, business or organization will be as follows:
 - a. RI Dues: One set of dues will be paid as RI will only recognize the 'Senior Designee' from the corporate entity, business or organization as a member.
 - b. District Dues: One set of dues will be paid as District 7210 will only recognize 'Senior Designee' from the corporate entity, business or organization .
 - c. Annual Club Dues: Includes weekly lunch, fellowship events, other club events,

and *The Rotarian* subscription (**\$300 per quarter** as of 2025-2026)

- d. *The Rotarian* Magazine: \$12 per *additional* designee
 - e. Should a change of membership status from corporate designee to active occur, the newly active person will pay regular active dues from the day the change occurs.
 - f. Paul Harris Fellow (PHF) Contribution: Optional Paul Harris contribution will be \$25 per designee per quarter and will remain on the invoice. Should they choose to pay it, the corporate entity, business or organization may pay it or the individual designees may pay it themselves.
6. **Attendance.** Attendance requirements will be as follows:
- a. Club Meetings: One designee per organization membership is permitted to attend meetings. If additional designees attend, they will pay for the cost of their lunch.
 - b. Fellowship Events: Two designees are permitted to attend fellowship events or other club events where there is a cost. (Same as one Rotarian bringing one guest) Additional designees or guests of designees can attend these events by paying the cost of the event.
 - c. No-cost Events: All designees are permitted to attend any events that do not have any cost associated with them.
7. **Badges.** Each designee will have a club name badge.
8. **Votes and quorum.** For the purpose of general meetings and club matters, designee present at the time of vote would represent the corporate entity, business or organization and vote on their behalf.
9. **Holding office.** The 'Senior Designee' can hold any office in the Rotary club to which the designee is elected in the normal way. (If another designee would like to hold an office, this can be discussed on a case-by-case basis.)
10. **Conversion.** A designee of the eligible corporation, while still an employee of the eligible corporation, may convert to an individual active membership of the club with approval of the club's board of directors. Dues, attendance, and other requirements will be the same as other active members.
11. **Bulletin and communication.** The 'Senior Designee' will receive the club's meeting notes and other communication. It is their responsibility to pass the information along to the other 1-2 designees. The designee attending the weekly meeting should also communicate information to the other designees.
- a. **All non-senior** designees will be added as Honorary Members
12. **Receipt of *The Rotarian*.** Each designee will receive a copy of *The Rotarian*. (Included in dues.)
13. **Public liability cover.** All designees will be included under the respective club liability insurance while participating in any approved club activities or projects, if applicable.
14. **Termination.** The process for terminating the membership of a designee or the eligible corporation will be the same as with active members.
