

The Powelton Club Rules for Guests

- 1. Proper decorum, conduct and dress are expected from the membership and their guests at all times. The General Manager and staff have been instructed by the Board of Directors to refuse service to any member or guest who conducts himself or herself in an improper, loud or unruly manner. Any member or guest requested to leave the Club premises as a result of his or her conduct or improper attire must leave the premises immediately and will be subject to disciplinary action by the Board of Directors.
- 2. Proper Attire: Members and their guests are required to wear proper attire at all times.
 - a. Clubhouse and Grounds:
 - i. Unacceptable attire includes: Athletic/jogging shorts other than tennis shorts and Bermuda shorts (knee length), tank tops, undershirts, bare tops, denim jeans or shorts (unless specified otherwise) and collarless shirts, other than those permitted on the tennis courts.
 - ii. Bathing suits and bare feet are permitted only in the pool and locker rooms.
 - iii. Men must remove hats and visors while in the dining areas and 19th hole. Hat brims must be facing forward at all times.
 - iv. Shoes must be worn in dining areas
 - v. Men are required to wear jackets when specified.
 - vi. Shirts must be tucked in at all times, except tennis shirts
 - b. Golf Course
 - i. Males, 12 years and older, shall wear collared shirts, tucked in, at all times on the course.
 - ii. Barefoot or shoeless play is not permitted
 - iii. Proper dress is required on the course by all members, guests and children
 - c. Tennis Courts
 - i. Waffled or grooved tennis shoes are not permitted.
 - ii. Predominately white tennis clothing must be worn at all times, with the exception of warmup attire, hats, and tennis shoes. White athletic-style tennis shirts may be collarless.
 - d. Pool
 - i. Bathing attire may be worn only at the pool.
 - ii. No metal hair accessories should be worn in the pool or pool area.
- 3. Dogs are not permitted on Club grounds
- 4. Cigar and Pipe smoking is not allowed in the clubhouse.
- 5. Oversized vehicles with advertising or equipment on them are required to park at the northeast corner of the parking lot, along the 10th tee.
- 6. Cell Phone Policy:
 - a. Using a cell phone for phone calls is strictly prohibited in all club dining areas; Main Dining Room, Grille Room, 19th Hole, President's Bar and Front Porch. Texting or browsing is permitted.

- b. Cell Phone use is discouraged on the golf course, tennis courts and at the Pool, but if necessary due care must be taken not to disturb others.
- c. Vibrating, rather than ringing phones are preferred. Generally, members and guests are asked to use good judgement and discretion when using cell phones.

7. Clubhouse and Grounds

- a. Children under the age of twelve (12) must be accompanied by a parent at all times unless participating in a club run activity.
- b. Children under sixteen (16) shall not be permitted in the Clubhouse unless accompanied by a parent or other member.
- c. Boys and girls under twelve (12) year years of age shall use the boy's or girl's locker rooms as appropriate. They are not allowed to use the men's or ladies' locker or shower rooms but may use toilet facilities.
- d. Food or beverages may not be brought to the Club by members or guests.
 - i. The Board of Directors may make an exception, with a written request.

8. Golf Course

- a. All guests must be registered with the Golf Professional upon the arrival to the Club.
- b. Children under the age of twelve (12) are not permitted on the course unless accompanied by a parent or adult, and certified by the Head Golf Professional.
- c. Children under the age of sixteen (16) are not permitted on the course before 1p.m. Tuesday through Sundays and Holidays.
 - i. Exceptions may be made at certain times of the year and under certain conditions by the Head Golf Professional or Club Manager.
 - ii. Children must give way to adults at all times
- d. Unacceptable attire, See Section 3, b.
- e. Fivesomes or more are not permitted during the scheduled season
- f. Teeing off at the 10th tee is not permitted between 8:30am and 12:00pm on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays. It is permitted at other times only if golfers are not on the 9th hole approach. On weekends and holidays, guests must be accompanied by a member.
- g. Guest are permitted during the winter. The winter guest fee is \$30. Members must register their guest in the Club Office.
- h. The Golf Professional or any member of the Board of Directors is authorized to ask any golfer to leave the grounds if his or her actions are unsatisfactory.
- i. Golf Carts:
 - i. Golf carts must stay outside of staked areas and at least 25 feet from tees and greens unless on a paved path.
 - ii. Golf carts are not permitted off of the golf course
 - iii. Children under 16 are not permitted to drive or use golf carts unless accompanied by an adult.
 - iv. Two persons may ride in a cart, no more.
 - v. Golf carts are rented under the following conditions:
 - 1. One through nine holes Full nine-hole rate
 - 2. One through ten holes full eighteen-hole rate
- j. Practice:
 - i. Practicing putting or chipping to the regular greens is not permitted
 - ii. Practice is allowed on the lower 7th green (sand trap and rough area) as well as the practice green by the first tee.
- k. Time of Play:
 - i. Maintenance (watering and mowing) before 8:00am shall have precedence over play.
 - ii. Play is not allowed on Mondays before 11:00am due to course maintenance.

9. Pool

- a. All members and guests must be registered with the Pool Director, or Lifeguard, upon the arrival to the Club's pool area.
- b. Any child under the age of twelve (12) must be attended by a parent or qualified sitter. To qualify, the sitter must be at least 16 years of age and the Club must receive note from the child's parent confirming that the sitter is qualified to be responsible to safeguard their child. The qualified non-member sitter may not make use of the club's golf course, tennis courts or pool.
- c. Swimming, or occupying the pool area is not allowed unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- d. Children who cannot pass the swimming test, administered by the Pool Director, may not enter the large pool, unless they are accompanied by an adult or under supervision of the Pool Director.
- e. The use of either pool by children wearing diapers is strictly prohibited.
- f. Glassware and china is strictly prohibited from the pool area.
- g. Outside food and beverages are not permitted.
- h. Smoking is not permitted inside the pool area

10. Tennis

- a. All guests must be registered online through the Club website prior to arrival of the Club.
- b. Play is not permitted on courts where nets have been lowered.
- c. For Acceptable Attire, see Section 3, c.
- d. Players entering or exiting the courts are asked to use the gate nearest their court.
- e. On Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays, and after 5 p.m. on weekdays children under sixteen (16) must yield courts to adults, if necessary.
- f. The Tennis Professional or any member of the Board of Directors is authorized to ask any tennis players to leave the grounds if his or her actions are unsatisfactory.
- g. Maximum court time (while others are waiting) for doubles is 2 hours. Singles is 1.5 hours.
