**Tom Zugibe and Peter Modeferri** 

Tom Zugibe is a current District Attorney in Rockland and Peter Modeferri is a private detective with the District Attorneys office. Tom shared with us a new initiative called <u>Donate Life</u> - <u>Rockland County Unites</u> in order to encourage individuales to donate their organs. Currently, New York State ranks 49<sup>th</sup> of the 50 states for organ donors with southern N.Y. being the worst. This initiative has seen a 20% increase in organ donors in the past year and a half. Tom shared some untrue myths that get in the way of donations.

- They will pull the plug sooner if you are a donor.
- My religion is against it.

The truth is that most religions believe that organ donation is the ultimate in unselfishness.

Peter then shared his personal story of being receiving a heart transplant two years ago. He had unknown heart disease as a child which went undiagnosed. He had experienced several episodes as an adult and prior to his transplant he had spent three months in a coma. It was the unfortunate death of a 39 year old marathon runner and organ donor that saved his life.

Peter also shared that he has had his new heart for two years and his physical health is good but it is harder to deal with the emotional part.

Organ donors can elect to donate all their organs, heart, lungs, kidneys, skin, eyes, liver, bones and tissues or elect to donate only certain body parts. A recent accident happened where a young man was left brain dead and donated every organ except his eyes.
