Program: Presented by **Vin Acocella** on the devastation & destruction during the historic upstate rainfall from <u>Hurricane Irene</u>. A video was shown to our club of all the historic devastation leveled against the upstate region by "**The Schohari Creek**". Record rainfall fell which made a creek become a river which totally destroyed, moved & relocated everything in its path. Picture after picture displayed the total destruction and the incredible power of a creek which rose to beyond record heights to destroy the countryside, valley and all Towns in its path. Vinnie's brothers house was pictured with the severe damage from not only the original Irene storm, but the following 2 week later storm which added to the already flooded areas. This recreated the excessive flooding and added to the magnitude of the 1st flooding. Hillsides became mudslides which poured into low areas and also into the overflowing creek/river torrent that washed away homes, roadways, Towns, all businesses and everything in its path. The total devastation was incredible and hard to fathom unless seen through this video. Cars buried in mud, buildings buried, houses moved from foundations and moved ½ mile away, houses completely destroyed were all part of the video taken by Vinnie. **Seeing is believing!**

The current situation has the people either trying to rebuild, stabilize or simply walking away from their homes & businesses from their complete loss. In some cases Insurance has covered much of the losses. In other cases, Federal funding has helped, in some cases funding was not available or was even denied for whatever terrible reason.

Summary: No one realized this was in our backyard & in our state until presented by these pictures. To see the enormity and gravity of the situation brought to our club, correctly stated the accurate scope of the storms power and destructive nature. We all dealt with the storm on our front, but nothing like the size & scope of the devastation dealt with by the upstate residents of New York. Our prayers for recovery go to the families of this region!
