Program:

President Jim Murphy enlightened us on interesting facts about Earthquakes. 1) Magnitude, energy release, 2) how far away you are. The ground that we're on is solid bedrock and you feel the waves because of the solid ground that we're on. In California because the energy that's released is absorbed by the ground which is crumbly 3) the Distance and 4) What kind of building are you in, wood frame homes are the safest, low wood frame houses can be flexible, the worst are brick, because that are built with mortar and are ridged and inflexible. The worst place to be is at the Epi-Center because of ground motion. A violent break in the continental plates will be fierce, first shocks as it breaks and the second shocks as waves. The scariest part about quakes is that there is no warring; it's not the quake itself but the Tsunami, the road way, bridges and airports. So, size, time & distance, Land mass, firm or jelloie and building structure are all important factors during an earthquake. Someday, LA will meet San Fran.
