Raj invited all to a free event on Saturday at 8:30AM on Elder Scams with Tom Zugibe as speaker. Oh yes, there will be free coffee!




Queen of Hearts: the magic # was 649 picked by our guest and Frank Ripa tried to claim it but it went to his whole table
