and Elizabeth the Town Museum Curator. Mary talked about the two Orangetown Museums and explained that the Salyer House is now used for offices and the Depew House is where the exhibits are now shown. The current exhibit was expected

to be a history of the longtime residents of Rockland – The Blauvelt Family. It was changed to "from Holland to here". Elizabeth then gave us a

history of the Dutch and what they did in the area. She told us that she was blessed to hear of t gentleman (George Way)from Staten Island who owns the largest Dutch collection of historic artifacts in the country. He



kindly lent the Depew Museum 140 items from his collection and they are now displayed in the Museum. Elizabeth also explained how the Museums collect all of the artifacts they possess and explained the process of authentication, registration, and storage. The Museums maintain over 6000 artifacts that have been authenticated. The Depew Museum is a 196 Chief Bill Harris Way, Orangeburg. Hours are Tuesday and Friday 10-2 and Sunday 1-4.
