Mark Griffith was recently in contact with Past President Mike Fury, who extends his best wishes and friendship to the Club.

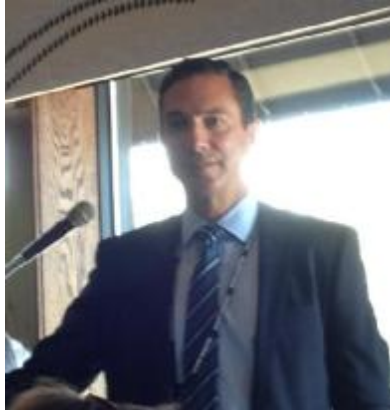
